



FLOWERS for the ALTAR

Instructions

Sign up for Your Desired Sunday on the Flower Calendar located on the bulletin board in the church. If the Sunday you want is already taken, you may designate one bouquet to be placed near the organ for that Sunday.

Fill out One of the Flower/Bulletin Sign-Up Sheets located in the envelope marked “Flowers” which is hanging on the bulletin board. Please be sure to designate whether you will pick up the flowers after the service or want them to be delivered to shut-ins.

Take the Flower Slip to the Church Office or put in the offering plate.

- For Easter and Christmas, the Flower Committee offers special altar flowers for purchase by the congregation.
- During Lent, no flowers may be placed on the altar, but you may place or order one low bouquet for the organ.
- For other Sundays, you may bring two bouquets of flowers from your own garden or you may order them from the florist of your choice.
- Flowers from your garden: Please pick up a set of liners from the church the Sunday before your date. You may then arrange the flowers at home in the liners and place them in the vases on the altar by 9 a.m. on your Sunday. **If you are arranging a bouquet for the organ, you will need to supply your own container.**

- **If you choose to pick up the flowers yourself after the service, please do not take the liners with you as they must be available for the next person to use. Thank you very much.**
